About five months ago, my son and I were in a car accident. I immediately had back and neck pain, as did my son. We are both asthmatic and take several medications. We both have American Medical ID bracelets that we wear. In all honesty, I never take mine off, but strangely enough, some sports my son plays in requires he take it off.

In any case, having the American Medical ID bracelets on helped when we had to call an ambulance. The EMTs immediately looked at our wrists and read the information.

Once inside the ambulance, they immediately checked both my son's and my oxygen saturation levels. I also have the emergency medical sticker on my vehicle. I feel more secure knowing I wear the bracelet and that I have the sticker. In the event I was knocked unconscious, I would have received the proper care. I am allergic to a medication, so it is crucial I wear my bracelet.
