I have several medical conditions and take certain medications that EMT and ER personnel need to know about in an emergency situation before any treatment can be given. However, I never thought I would need a medical ID to speak for me.

I had an accident in the spring of 2007, and although I was not badly hurt I did need to go to the emergency room. I was upset and scared as well as in pain and had a difficult hard time even answering simple questions like what my name was, let alone listing all my conditions and my medications.

As I was lying in the ambulance on a backboard and in a cervical collar in tears and trying to force myself to think straight, one EMT saw my bracelet, read it and asked me if it listed all of the most important information. I confirmed his assumption and he said "that's all we need."

The EMTs were able to treat me with confidence since they had this vital information. When we arrived at the hospital, he told me that with all the medical conditions I have my medical ID was a lifesaver.
